### Mosaic Response Plan Coronavirus (COVID-19)

#### STAGE 1 - CONFIRMED (COVID-19) CASES IN TEXAS

- All worship, ministries, and meetings in our church remain active.
- Extra sanitation and cleaning will be performed throughout our facilities.
- If you are not feeling well, it is best to stay home and watch our services on our live stream via Facebook.
- We recommend no handshakes or hugging. Communicate love through words rather than physical contact.
- Wash hands with soap thoroughly for a minimum of 20 seconds.
- Avoid touching your face (mouth, nose, eyes) with hands.
- Cover all coughs and sneezes with a tissue and wash your hands thoroughly afterward.
- Live stream services available if feeling uncomfortable attending Mosaic in person.
- Church bulletins will be available.

#### STAGE 2 - CONFIRMED (COVID-19) CASES IN COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS

- All worship, ministries, and meetings in our church remain active.
- Extra cleaning and sanitation before and after worship services.
- All potlucks are suspended and no food served on church premises\* (see addendums)
- Tithe and offerings will be collected at the back doors of our sanctuary. Offering plates will not be passed.
- Online giving through Adventist Giving recommended, brought to the church during the week or mail-in directly to the church.
- Bulletins will be available but will not be distributed at doors.

# STAGE 3 - CONFIRMED (COVID-19) CASES IN OUR CHURCH, SCHOOLS, OR UPON ADVISEMENT OF LOCAL, STATE, OR FEDERAL HEALTH OFFICIALS

- No in-person worship services will be held in our church. (see addendums)
- Worship services will only be available over our live stream. (see addendums)
- Tithe and offerings will be received in one of three ways:
  - 1. Adventist Giving Online (https://adventistgiving.org)
  - 2. Mail-in directly to the church
  - 3. Personally deliver to the church and place inside the designated black drop box located to the right of the entry door.
- All in-person ministry meetings are suspended.
- Ministry meetings can be conducted virtually through online meetings.

### \*EFFECTIVE - 6/18/21 — modification to Stage 2

The church board granted an exception and approval to change food served at the church and potlucks on Stage 2 of the Mosaic COVID-19 Response Plan.

It has been proposed and approved to bring in prepackaged food for VBS, Adventurers, Pathfinders and Evangelism series on church premises as well as to begin allowing potlucks with restriction (see below).

## **Potluck Policy**

- 1. Kitchen one-time deep cleaning by a special cleaning service prior to any preparation of any food.
- 2. Food is to be bought by the church and prepared at the church
- 3. Food preppers; Limit 6-7 individuals only in the kitchen and wear masks and gloves
- 4. The door should be placed back on the kitchen entrance and kept closed during potlucks.
- 5. Prepared and served from the church kitchen by food preppers that are masked and gloved. Food should not be prepared anywhere else.

# **Modification to Stage 2 and Stage 3 of the Mosaic COVID-19 Response Plan. EFFECTIVE 09/12/21**

Anyone who attends in-person worship services at Mosaic that subsequently test positive for COVID-19 should notify the church office as soon as possible and make us aware so we can communicate appropriately and attempt to prevent church community spread.

The Mosaic Church office (pastoral staff), upon being notified, will do the following:

- a. Attempt contact tracing to assess the extent of exposure.
- b. Retain all information confidential.
- c. Notify all individuals who were in close proximity (Sabbath School & those in adjacent Sanctuary seats) to the exposed person and inform them that someone who tested positive for COVID-19 was at church the past Sabbath and recommend they seek medical attention.
- d. An email will be sent to all church members informing them of the possibility and potential COVID-19 exposure.
- e. A text message will be sent, out of an abundance of caution, notifying church members that a COVID-19 alert was distributed to their email client so church members can make informed decisions concerning their individual and family's health.
- 2. These steps will ensure better communication during the current rise of the Delta Strain and allow for continual and ongoing in-person worship services without the need to close the church facility or its associated services.
- 3. Please remember to follow and continue to practice our existing precautions already outlined in our current COVID-19 policies and procedures. Here are just four:
  - a. Watch your distance (minimum 3–6 feet).
  - b. Follow all aspects of proper personal hygiene, including handwashing (20 seconds minimum).
  - c. Wear a mask if unvaccinated and if vaccinated, wear a mask if needed for your safety and that of others as we encourage responsible immunization/vaccination.
  - d. <u>If you are exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms</u> or have recently been exposed to someone with COVID-19, we welcome you to worship with us via our online services at <u>MosaicSDA.org/live</u> until 14-days without symptoms before returning to Mosaic.
